

ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EXETER,
LUZERNE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING THE
EXETER TOWNSHIP ZONING ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the Exeter Township Supervisors are desirous of amending the Exeter Township Zoning Ordinance as same relates to signage in the Township.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EXETER AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE

Section 801 (5) "Sign" (b) (paragraph 15) of the Exeter Township Zoning Ordinance is hereby Amended to read as follows:


A temporary sign made of paper, cardboard or similar material and intended to attract public attention shall not be attached to any lamp post, utility policy, shade tree, or public structure or building. Such signs shall include political posters, notices of household sales, and notices of bazaars, picnics, and other such functions conducted by charitable and non-profit groups. When such signs are permitted, they shall not be posted sooner than forty-five (45) days before the date of the event advertised and they shall not remain posted for more than thirty (30) days after the date of the event advertised.


SECTION TWO
