## MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE EXETER TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MONDAY, JUNE 6, 2022 AT 7:00 PM

The Exeter Township Board of Supervisors held their monthly meeting on June 6th, 2022 at 7:00 PM in the Township Municipal Building. Present were Supervisors Fetch, Kreseski, Pendolphia, Felker and Chairman Redmond.

The minutes of the regular meeting held on May 2, 2022 were read and approved as follows: Motion by Kreseski, seconded by Fetch. Vote - All yes.

The Treasurer's Report was read by the assistant secretary treasurer. Motion by Fetch, seconded by Kreseski to accept the reading of the Treasurer's Report. Vote - All yes

The monthly bills were reviewed by the supervisors prior to the meeting. Motion by Fetch and seconded by Pendolphia to approve and pay the bills. Vote - All yes

The chairman opened the floor to the public comment on the Agenda items only. There were no questions or comments.

The board discussed the cost estimate of \$39,567.00 from PennEastern Engineers to complete the Guide Rail on Lockville Road. Motion to put the project up for bid by Pendolphia and seconded by Fetch with all voting in favor.

Chairman Redmond informed that the public that Schooley Ave will be closed for a bridge replacement project between Searfoss Road and Della Lane starting June 1st, 2022 and continuing until September 1st, 2022.

Motion to approve and keep the Comcast Agreement Proposal as current and not take additional funds from residents by Redmond, seconded by Pendolphia. Vote - All yes

Motion to approve Harding Recreational Committee use of Municipal Building, parking areas, and baseball field for "Touch A Truck" event on September 18th, 2022 and "Meet your Local Author Day" on October 2nd 2022. Motion by Kreseski and seconded by Felker with all voting in favor.

Motion to approve permit at no cost for Jillian Grochal for use of Township Park and Tennis Court Area for a birthday party on June 11th, 2022 with more than 25 attendees. Motion by Fetch seconded by Felker. Vote - All yes.

Police Report was read and is on file.

Zoning and Building Report is as follows: Zoning - 3 Permits Building - 8 Permits

Sewage - 1 Permit

A discussion occurred between supervisors regarding multiple complaints on trailers being moved without permits. Waiting for a response from BHW Construction Consult Services.

The Chairman opened the floor to the public.

Bernard Vincavage asked about the status of the guardrail on Lockville Road. Supervisors explained that a motion was passed to have bids on the project in by July 2022.

Art Becker asked if the Recreational Committee requires any other documentation for their upcoming events. Supervisors explained the motion was approved and nothing else is required.
