## MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF EXETER TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TUESDAY JULY 5, 2022, AT 7:00 PM

The Exeter Township Board of Supervisors held their monthly meeting on July 5<sup>th</sup>, 2022, at 7:00 PM in the Township Municipal Building. Present were supervisors Fetch, Felker, Kreseski, Pendolphia and Chairman Redmond.

The minutes of the regular meeting held on June 6<sup>th</sup>, 2022, were read and approved as follows: motion by Kreseski, seconded by Fetch. Vote – All yes

The Treasurer's Report was read by the assistant secretary treasurer. Motion by Fetch, seconded by Pendolphia to accept the reading of the Treasurer's Report. Vote – All yes

The monthly bills were reviewed by the supervisors prior to the meeting. Motion by Fetch, seconded by Pendolphia to approve and pay the bills. Vote- All yes

An Executive meeting was held prior to the meeting on June 20<sup>th</sup> from 6:30 PM to 7:00 PM regarding personnel.

As this was the publicized date and time for the opening of bids relative to the Lockville Guide Rail Project, Chairman Redmond opened two (2) bids that were received timely by the Township. Minichi submitted a bid for \$62,222.00. Kriger Construction submitted a bid for \$61,863.00. The board deferred selection of one of the bids until they were reviewed by the Township Engineer and a recommendation was made relative to the same. Motion by Fetch to have engineers review bids before accepting, seconded by Pendolphia with all voting in favor.

Motion to allow Exeter Township Recreational Committee to photograph Police Station Badge for a possible Puzzle Series Fundraiser by Fetch and seconded by Pendolphia. Vote – All yes

Motion to allow Exeter Township Recreational Committee to use Municipal Building for a meeting in August for Touch a Truck Event. Motion by Pendolphia, seconded by Kreseski. Vote – All yes

Memorandum of Understanding for John Symons to be off without pay every Friday for 6 months was not yet received. Motion to table until future meeting by Fetch, seconded by Kreseski with all voting in favor.

Motion by Pendolphia, seconded by Fetch to adopt Resolution 2022-5 Multimodal Transportation Grant for demolition and replacement of a culvert pipe on Hastie Lane with Paige Evans as designated document handler. Vote – All yes

Motion to accept LSA Grant of \$40,000 by Fetch, seconded by Kreseski with all voting in favor.

Motion to purchase truck from Bonner Chevrolet. Motion by Fetch and seconded by Pendolphia. Vote – All yes

Police report contained 60 Police Related Calls for month of June 2022.

Chairman opened the floor to the public.
