

**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING
OF EXETER TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
MONDAY AUGUST 1, 2022 AT 7:00 PM**

The Exeter Township Board of Supervisors held their monthly meeting on August 1st, 2022 at 7:00 PM in the Township Municipal Building. Present were supervisors Felker, Kreseski, Pendolphia, and Chairman Redmond.

The minutes of the regular meeting held on July 5th, 2022 were read and approved as follows: motion by Kreseski, seconded by Pendolphia. Vote - All yes

The Treasurer's Report was read by the assistant secretary treasurer. Motion by Kreseski, seconded by Felker to accept the reading of the Treasurer's Report. Vote - All yes

The monthly bills were reviewed by the supervisors prior to the meeting. Motion by Pendolphia and seconded by Kreseski to approve and pay the bills with all voting in favor.

An executive meeting was held prior to the Township Meeting on July 18th at 8:00 PM.

There were no questions or comments from the floor on Agenda Items.

Motion to hire John Horn as a probationary employee for the position of part-time Road Department Employee at a rate of \$12.00 per hour retroactively to his start date on July 26th, 2022. Motion by Kreseski and seconded by Pendolphia with all voting in favor.

Motion to authorize our solicitor, Gene Molino, to prepare stormwater management ordinance and advertise the same for approval at the September meeting. Motion by Kreseski, seconded by Pendolphia with all voting in favor.

Discussed purchasing logos for Exeter Township Road Department Trucks. Supervisors decided to get a price for lettering and table until the next meeting.

Motion to have Secretary Treasurer advertise for part-time police officer positions by Pendolphia, seconded by Felker. Vote - All yes

Motion to change purchase cost of Township Road Department Vehicle from \$45,109.46 to \$47,102.68 with the difference being \$1,993.22. Motion by Kreseski, seconded by Pendolphia with all voting in favor.

A Memorandum of Understanding for John Symons to be off without pay every Friday for 6 months of the year was presented. Motion by Kreseski and seconded by Pendolphia. Vote - All yes

Supervisors informed that the Multi Modal Transportation Grant Application has been submitted as of July 21st, 2022.

There was not a Police or Sewage Report provided.

There was one building report on file.

Chairman opened the floor to the public.

Gina Felker asked if the Part-Time Police Position is temporary. Supervisor Redmond advised it could be since we will be transitioning to the Regional Police Department.

Marilyn Latorre asked what townships have joined the Regional Police Department. Supervisor Redmond advised it would be Wyoming, West Wyoming, Exeter Township, Exeter Borough, and West Pittston. Attorney Gene Molino explained there are Regional Police Department meetings every second Thursday of the month that supply more information.

Joe Panzitta asked if Exeter Township Police were involved in the break in at the powerplant but was advised it was taken over by the State Police instead.

Nereo Ninotti commented that water runoff from Marcy and Miller Roads is eroding the street and needs to be fixed. Pendolphia advised he will inform the Road Department of the issue.

Larren Stahl discussed the Jake Breaks signs in the township. Supervisors were informed one of the signs is covered by overlying trees and needs to be made visible.

Linda Stahl questioned if she should be calling 911 for all incidents or only emergency incidents.

Linda Ninotti asked if we are selling an old truck to buy the new one. Pendolphia advised our old truck is becoming unusable and will be put out for bid.

With there being no further business the meeting was adjourned at 8:00 PM. Motion by Kreseski, seconded by Pendolphia with all voting in favor.
