

## TNR (Trap Neuter Release) voucher tips:

- Appointments should always be required before you can receive a voucher. If a volunteer trapper is assisting you, your name should be put on the vouchers, not the trapper. This is for accountability within the Township.
- TNR appointments are limited to a max of 3 at a time so we will not give out more than 3 at a time to a resident/trapper volunteer. You can come back for more vouchers closer to the next appt.
- Cats **MUST** come in a trap. Exceptions are for friendly strays but must be approved by scheduling. This is for the safety of the staff and the caretakers handling the cats before surgery.
- Loaner traps are available at NNN clinic. Traps are available 1 week BEFORE your surgery date.
- Pregnancies are terminated. This TNR program is for free roaming outside cats. **No pets.**
- ALL will be left ear tipped. Cats receive a rabies vaccine, distemper vaccine under 1 year old, flea, worming and ear mite treatments, fluids and long-acting pain medicine.

**SCHEDULE FERAL/STRAY** are booked under **LION**. You can request 3 appointments per week. **You must fill out the form for each cat.** Any additional appointments will be denied.

**IMPORTANT when scheduling a feral cat: If you do not know the sex, age and color of the cat, insert female, 1 year old, 7 lbs and black for a color. Details will get corrected at time of surgery.**
