

**THE MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL MEETING
OF THE EXETER TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
MONDAY, JULY 1ST, 2024, AT 7:00 PM**

ADMINISTRATION

The Exeter Township Board of Supervisors held their regular monthly meeting on Monday, July 1st, 2024, at 7:00 PM in the Township Municipal Building. Present were Supervisors Pendolphia, Kreseski, and Fetch along with Attorney Molino and the secretary.

Motion by Pendolphia, seconded by Kreseski to approve the reading of the regular meeting minutes with all voting in favor.

Motion by Kreseski, seconded by Pendolphia to approve the reading of the special meeting minutes. Vote – All yes.

Motion by Pendolphia, seconded by Kreseski to accept the reading of the Treasurer's Report with all voting in favor.

There were no comments from the floor on Agenda items.

The monthly bills were reviewed by the Supervisors prior to the start of the meeting. Motion by Pendolphia, seconded by Kreseski with all voting in favor to approve and pay the bills.

Motion to approve Resolution 2024-3 which establishes a policy of the Township of Exeter to deny all anonymous requests for access to records under the Right-to-Know law consistent with discretion afforded to agencies pursuant to Section 702 of the act. Motion by Kreseski, seconded by Pendolphia. Vote – All yes.
