

**THE MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING
OF THE EXETER TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
MONDAY, AUGUST 5TH, 2024, AT 7:00 PM**

ADMINISTRATION

The Exeter Township Board of Supervisors held their regular monthly meeting on Monday, August 5th, 2024, at 7:00 PM in the Township Municipal Building. Present were Supervisors Pendolphia, Felker, Kreseski, Fetch and Chairperson Redmond along with Attorney Molino and the secretary.

Motion by Fetch, seconded by Pendolphia to approve the reading of the regular meeting minutes with Felker and Kreseski voting in favor. Chairperson Redmond abstained due to absence.

Motion by Pendolphia, seconded by Felker to accept the reading of the Treasurer's Report with all voting in favor.

There were no comments from the floor on Agenda items.

The monthly bills were reviewed by the Supervisors prior to the start of the meeting. Motion by Fetch, seconded by Felker with all voting in favor to approve and pay the bills.

NEW BUSINESS

Motion for the Harding Recreation Committee to use the Municipal Building restrooms and parking lot Sunday October 27th from 2 pm – 4 pm to host a Trunk-Or-Treat event. Motion by fetch, seconded by Pendolphia. Vote – All yes.

Motion to accept Resolution 2024-4 which authorizes the exploration of a project to regionalize zoning and code enforcement services and to study the feasibility of regionalized zoning and code enforcement with the Boroughs of Exeter, West Pittston, West Wyoming, and Wyoming. Motion by Fetch, seconded by Pendolphia with all voting in favor.

Motion to approve temporary construction easement agreement between Jeffrey and Pauli Zaykowski and Exeter Township relative to vehicular and pedestrian traffic around the Hastie Lane Culvert Replacement Project. Motion by Pendolphia, seconded by Felker with all voting in favor.

REPORTS

Sergeant Lombardo from Wyoming Area Regional Police was present to address resident concerns and advised there were a total of 27 calls for Exeter Township in the month of July.

Harding Fire Company reported 15 calls in the month of July.

Vice Chairperson Fetch informed residents the Hastie Lane Project is predicted to begin on September 23rd, 2024.
