

**THE MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING
OF THE EXETER TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 3RD, 2024, AT 7:00 PM**

ADMINISTRATION

The Exeter Township Board of Supervisors held their regular monthly meeting on Tuesday, September 3rd, 2024, at 7:00 PM in the Township Municipal Building. Present were Supervisors Pendolphia, Felker, Kreseski, Fetch and Chairperson Redmond along with the secretary.

Motion by Pendolphia, seconded by Fetch to approve the reading of the regular meeting minutes. Vote – All yes.

Motion by Fetch, seconded by Pendolphia to accept the reading of the Treasurer's Report with all voting in favor.

There were no comments from the floor on Agenda items.

The monthly bills were reviewed by the Supervisors prior to the start of the meeting. Motion by Pendolphia, seconded by Felker with all voting in favor to approve and pay the bills.
