

**THE MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING
OF THE EXETER TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
MONDAY, DECEMBER 2ND, 2024, AT 7:00 PM**

ADMINISTRATION

The Exeter Township Board of Supervisors held their regular monthly meeting on Monday, December 2nd, 2024, at 7:00 PM in the Township Municipal Building. Present were Supervisors Pendolphia Felker, Kreseski, Fetch and Chairperson Redmond along with the secretary.

Motion by Pendolphia, seconded by Felker to amend the agenda prior to the start of the meeting. Vote – All yes.

Motion by Kreseski, seconded by Pendolphia to approve the reading of the regular meeting minutes. Vote – All yes.

Motion by Fetch, seconded by Felker to accept the reading of the Treasurer's Report with all voting in favor.

There were no comments from the floor on Agenda items.

The monthly bills were reviewed by the Supervisors prior to the start of the meeting. Motion by Fetch, seconded by Pendolphia with all voting in favor to approve and pay the bills.

Motion to hire Edward Publik as Truck Driver/Laborer for the Exeter Township Road Department at \$21 per hour effective December 2nd, 2024. Motion by Fetch, seconded by Felker. Vote – All yes.

Chairperson Redmond informed residents the monthly work session held on December 16th at 6 pm has been advertised to be a special voting meeting where the board will be voting on the 2025 budget.

Motion to hire Girard Mecadon as temporary zoning hearing Attorney at \$150 per hour for the matter of a building permit for Richard Garmize. Motion by Pendolphia, seconded by Fetch with all voting in favor.
