By law, all first-time hunters and trappers, regardless of age, must successfully complete Hunter-Trapper Education training before they can buy a hunting or trapping license in Pennsylvania. Participants who successfully pass the test at the end of the class will receive a training certificate, which is recognized throughout North America.
