

**THE MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING

ADMINISTRATION

The Exeter Township Board of Supervisors held their regular monthly meeting on Monday, February 2nd, 2026, at 7:00 PM in the Township Municipal Building. Present were Supervisors Fetch, Felker, Smith, and Pendolphia along with Attorney Molino.

Motion by Fetch, seconded by Felker to approve the reading of the regular meeting minutes with all voting in favor.

Motion by Fetch, seconded by Felker to accept the reading of the Treasurer's Report with all voting in favor.
