

**THE MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING
OF THE EXETER TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
MONDAY, MARCH 2nd, 2026, AT 7:00 PM**

ADMINISTRATION

The Exeter Township Board of Supervisors held their regular monthly meeting on Monday, March 2nd, 2026, at 7:00 PM in the Township Municipal Building. Present were Vice Chairman Pendolphia, Supervisors Fetch, Felker, and Smith along with Attorney Molino and Secretary Sejas.

Motion by Fetch, seconded by Felker to approve the reading of the regular meeting minutes with all voting in favor.

Motion by Felker, seconded by Fetch to accept the reading of the Treasurer's Report with all voting in favor.

There were no comments from the floor on Agenda items.

The monthly bills were reviewed by the Supervisors prior to the start of the meeting. Motion by Fetch, seconded by Felker with all voting in favor to approve and pay the bills.

NEW BUSINESS

1. Motion made by Fetch and seconded by Smith to adopt Ordinance 3 authorizing the fire department to bill insurance carriers for emergency response services. Motion carried unanimously.
2. Motion by Fetch, seconded by Smith to adopt resolution 3 -2026 for Municipal use and fees, vote all yes.
3. Motion made by Smith and seconded by Felker to approve the resolution for the DCNR grant. Motion carried unanimously.
4. The 2025 audit report, together with the auditor's recommendations, was presented to the Board. Upon motion by Smith, seconded by Felker, the report was accepted. The motion carried unanimously.
5. Board approval of transition to Microsoft 365- vote all yes.

6. The Road Department applications were reviewed by the supervisors, with interviews to be conducted by Supervisors Pendolphia and Smith.
