

**THE MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING
OF THE EXETER TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
MONDAY, APRIL 6th , 2026, AT 7:00 PM**

ADMINISTRATION

The Exeter Township Board of Supervisors held their regular monthly meeting on Monday, April 6th , 2026, at 7:00 PM in the Township Municipal Building. Present were Chairwoman Redmond, Vice Chairman Pendolphia, Supervisors Fetch, Felker, and Smith along with Attorney Molino and Secretary Sejas.

Motion by Smith, seconded by Pendolphia to approve the reading of the regular meeting minutes with all voting in favor. Chairwoman Redmond Abstained due to her absence at last month's meeting.

Motion by Felker, seconded by Smith to accept the reading of the Treasurer's Report with all voting in favor.

There were no comments from the floor on Agenda items.

The monthly bills were reviewed by the Supervisors prior to the start of the meeting. Motion by Smith, seconded by Felker with all voting in favor to approve and pay the bills. Supervisor Smith abstains from Atlas bill due to his Employment there.

NEW BUSINESS

1. Motion by Pendolphia, seconded by Smith, to update the agenda to include March 26, 2026 under New Business 1. Vote all yes.
2. Motion by Pendolphia, seconded by Smith to appoint Jonathan Eyerman and Zachary Monahan to the position of Road Workers at an hourly rate of \$20.00
3. Motion by Pendolphia, seconded by Felker to adopt Resolution 2026-4 to set Fire and EMS fees for Emergency Services. Vote- all yes.
4. Supervisor Smith provided an update regarding the DCNR Park Grant application, which is due at the end of April. No Motion
5. Chairwoman Redmond emphasized that all requests submitted to the Township must include complete contact information, including the submitter's name and phone number. Anonymous submissions will not be processed. She also reminded everyone that Exeter Township maintains a

zero-tolerance policy for discriminatory or offensive language. no Motion made but approved by all supervisors.
