

**THE MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING
OF THE EXETER TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
MONDAY, MAY 4th , 2026, AT 7:00 PM**

A public work session was held at 6:00 p.m. The Board discussed public concerns related to BHW operations. Residents and Jason Humenanski of BHW were present and participated in the discussion.

ADMINISTRATION

The Exeter Township Board of Supervisors held their regular monthly meeting on Monday, May 4th , 2026, at 7:00 PM in the Township Municipal Building. Present were Chairwoman Redmond, Vice Chairman Pendolphia, Supervisors Fetch, Felker, and Smith along with Attorney Molino and Secretary Sejas.
