

**THE MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING
OF THE EXETER TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
MONDAY, JUNE 1st , 2026, AT 7:00 PM**

ADMINISTRATION

The Exeter Township Board of Supervisors held their regular monthly meeting on Monday, June 1st , 2026, at 7:00 PM in the Township Municipal Building. Present were Chairwoman Redmond (virtually), Vice Chairman Pendolphia, Supervisors Fetch, Smith along with Attorney Molino and Secretary Sejas.

Motion by Pendolphia, seconded by Fetch to approve the reading of the regular meeting minutes with all voting in favor.

Motion by Pendolphia, seconded by Smith to accept the reading of the Treasurer's Report with all voting in favor.

There were no comments from the floor on Agenda items.

The monthly bills were reviewed by the Supervisors prior to the start of the meeting. Motion by Fetch, seconded by Pendolphia with all voting in favor to approve and pay the bills. Supervisor Smith abstains from Atlas bill due to his Employment there.

NEW BUSINESS

1. Motion by Pendolphia, seconded by Smith to approve the COSTARS Purchase of a new leaf blower and trailer- Vote all yes.
2. Motion by Pendolphia, seconded by Smith to authorize a loan in the amount of \$650,000 for Paving Improvements on Pecks, Jean and Church Roads. Vote all yes.
3. Review of Hometown Heroes Banners paperwork requested by Supervisor Felker. No motion.
4. Motion by Pendolphia, seconded By Smith to approve the purchase of a skid steer for the Road Department prior to the July1st price increase. Vote all yes.
5. Motion by Fetch, seconded by Pendolphia to authorize the deposit of Park Funds into a CD account. Vote- all yes.

Resident Mike Santee of Wilson Avenue inquired about the properties along the waterfront and the related paperwork. Vice Chairman Pendolphia explained that the Township is actively working on the matter, but it is a complex and costly process. Mr. Santee also asked whether a pole barn could be constructed if Mike Benish sells his property. He was advised to contact BHW, as they handle the Township's zoning matters and building permit applications.

Joe Panzitta reminded residents that the 248th anniversary of the Harding Massacre will be observed on June 30th. He also provided updates and shared historical information regarding the event.
